

Application for SciLifeLab Funding of a Technology Development Project (TDP)

This document contains instructions for applying for funding of a Technology Development Project (TDP) 2019–2021.

The purpose of the 2018 Technology Development Project (TDP) call is to empower development and optimization of technologies to help SciLifeLab national infrastructure facilities offer improved and new services to their customers and to keep the SciLifeLab infrastructure profile at the cutting-edge. Applicants of a TDP can be:

- researchers or staff scientists at the SciLifeLab infrastructure
- researchers or staff scientists at other Swedish infrastructures
- individual researchers at a Swedish university/institute

Applicants should consult a relevant [SciLifeLab facility/platform](#) to investigate the interest of their proposal, and statements of support should be documented upon request. Proposals for technologies that do not fit into existing SciLifeLab facilities need stronger justification. Applications will be evaluated and ranked by the SciLifeLab Management Group based on technological and strategical importance. Decisions on funding of TDPs will be taken at the SciLifeLab Board meeting in November 2018, and the funding will be available from January 2019. The funded TDPs should be aimed for incorporation as new services in SciLifeLab infrastructure facilities in Jan 2021 without requirement of additional SciLifeLab funding. As an alternative, but more limited option, a funded TDP can be proposed by a Swedish university to become a new SciLifeLab facility in conjunction with the international evaluation in 2020.

How to apply:

You apply by filling in the web-based form and by uploading CV, and the TDP main application incl. budget as pdf documents where indicated.

7. CV and publication list of responsible researcher *

Prepare a maximum 2 pages CV for the responsible researcher containing appropriate research experience and 10 selected, relevant publications. Save as a pdf and name the file "CV_Name of the TDP", and upload in the web-based form.

8. TDP application including budget. *

The funding from SciLifeLab is a maximum of 1.5 MSEK per year for up to two years (2019–2020) and can typically cover:

- 1. salary, or part of salary, for a researcher (post doc, staff scientist etc.) in charge of developing the technology*
- 2. costs for purchasing critical reagents/consumables/materials.*

*Fill in the **TDP Application Including Budget Template** according to the fixed headings. Use Times New Roman font size 11 and maximum of 3 A4 pages, including any figures. Please note that any content beyond the specified maximum page counts will not be taken into account when considering applications. Save the document as pdf and name it "TDP application_Name of the TDP" and upload in the web-based form.*

IMPORTANT to note about the template:

When you double-click on the embedded budget table in the word document an excel document will automatically open. Fill in your budget in this excel document then close it. You do not have to save the excel prior to closing as the figures and sums are automatically entered into the word template. Specify all costs and revenues in kSEK.
