The list with projects suggested for funding was presented. All projects were scored by the reviewers on defined criteria, and ultimately ranked in relation to the other projects the reviewer scored. The 3 highest ranked projects were suggested for funding.

## Comments from the Steering Group:

- It's a very close gap between project number 2 of the top ranked projects and the rest of the projects in the list
- The Steering group suggested to provide feedback to projects ranked 4<sup>th</sup> to 7th
- Can extra funding be made available to fund more NEST projects?
- Important to give the funded NEST projects possibilities to present their plans and research progress in DDLS events.

**ACTION:** The DDLS Steering approved the call process and agreed to send the final list of top three applications to the SciLifeLab board for a decision.

Note: The top three applications also need to be approved by the WASP board (on March 25, 2025) before they are finally announced as approved NEST projects.
