8 Update from Research school

The DDLS Research school (RS) Annual Meeting and kick-off for the RS at Djurönäset was well attended and highly appreciated. Three full days for the PhD- students to meet, network and also attend the first course of the RS.

A PhD student Council is being formed. This council will act as a contact node between the RSMG and the students, contribute to the RS development and suggest and/or arrange social activities during the annual meetings

The DDLS PhD Project call 2024 is ongoing and now in the phase of advertising for PhD-students. Ideally new PhD-students start no later than October 2025.

The need for an admission lead for the DDLS PhD Project call 2025 was discussed. This is an intensive role for a few months each year and needs to be agreed upon in good time before the next call.

A DDLS Research School Curriculum Working Group (RCW) has been set up to take overall responsibility for the RS curriculum

Next DDLS RS Annual meeting for PhD-students and supervisors will be on 17-20 March 2026.

## 9 How to proceed with the postdoc program

Presenter: Olli Kallioniemi

Lukas Käll has accepted the position as DDLS Research School Director for Postdoc Program. As newly appointed Lukas will be invited to the upcoming NRG-meeting, May 8 and to the next DDLS SG meeting to present his vision for the program.

### Comments from the DDLS Steering Group:

- While mobility should be encouraged, categorically excluding all applicants from the same department may not always be the best approach for nurturing talent. E.g. Some may have just undertaken mobility and are in their first year in a new place.
- Identifying high-quality Principal Investigators (PIs) may be a limiting factor in the recruitment process.
- Projects should not be too narrowly defined; instead, flexibility should be allowed so that the postdoc and PI can collaboratively shape the project.
- Allowing short-term prior work with the PI could be seen as beneficial, as it can lead to stronger and more well-aligned project proposals.
- The program must remain agile in order to respond effectively to the rapidly evolving job market, such as the situation in the US.



10	Al and data science are key strategic areas within SciLifeLab, including the work of the Data Science Nodes. To ensure alignment, the Data Science Nodes need to coordinate and collaborate with other data-focused facilities across the organization through clear strategies and projects.
